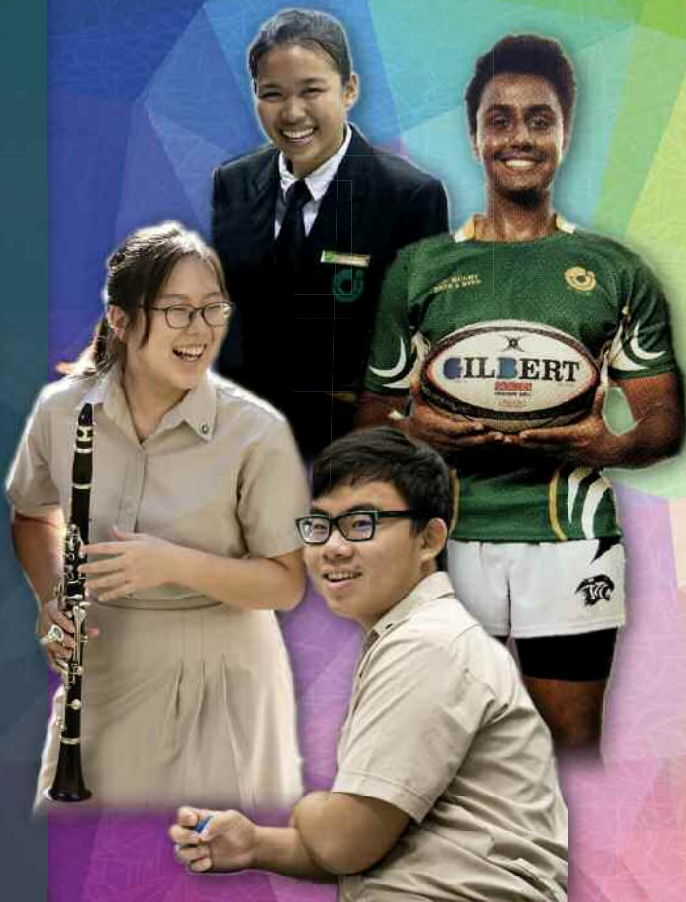

Alumni (Class of 1982, Pioneer Batch)

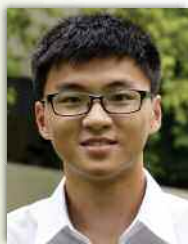
Tung Siew Hoong is the Director of the Portfolio Execution Group (PEG), a part of Singapore's sovereign wealth fund, GIC. In this role, Mr Tung oversees trade execution, treasury management, portfolio rebalancing, passive management and securities lending.

Mr Tung joined GIC in 1990 as a Senior Economist, coordinating the asset allocation process for the firm. His responsibilities included making investment recommendations on strategic asset allocation. Prior to assuming his current post at PEG, Mr Tung was the Head of Fixed Income Department (FID) from 2010 to 2015. He had been with FID since 1996, and had stints in European Government Bonds and emerging markets.

Aside from his formal appointment at GIC, Mr Tung has been a member of the Singapore Foreign Exchange Market Committee since April 2009. He also served as a board member of the Emerging Markets Traders Association from 2001 to 2015. On top of these, Mr Tung was appointed as a member of the Central Provident Fund Board in July 2010.

After graduating from Jurong Junior College in 1982, among the college's pioneer cohort of students, Mr Tung went on to further his studies at the National University of Singapore. He graduated with a Master of Social Science degree in Statistics and Economics from NUS in 1990.

Huan Wen was a motivated student who showed tenacity in his pursuit of academic excellence. Diligent and determined, he was always eager to learn and improve. He initiated study groups with his peers and regularly sought his tutors for consultations to further hone his mastery of the various subjects. Due to his excellent academic performance, Huan Wen was awarded the Edusave Merit Bursary in 2015. During the Overseas Values in Action trip to Cambodia in 2015, he exhibited humility and maturity as a supportive team player, willingly taking on laborious and unglamorous tasks such as the mixing of cement in preparation for the construction phase of the project.

Huan Wen's maturity, discipline and sense of responsibility make him a good role model and leader amongst his peers. With outstanding performance in both his academic and non-academic commitments, he is indeed truly deserving of the Best Overall Performance Award.

Wei Ting is a young lady who is committed to serving the larger community. Her dedication is demonstrated through the various volunteering assignments she undertook in the college and with various organisations.

Wei Ting volunteered as an Orientation Group Leader in the College Orientation in 2016 to familiarise the new students with the college. She was jovial and enthusiastic when leading her juniors and took good care of their well-being even after the Orientation. She also participated in the “Sign for SG50” in 2015, a carnival jointly organised by YouthBeat and the Singapore Association of the Deaf. Together with her classmates, she set up two traditional games booths to engage visitors in raising awareness for the deaf community.

During the college’s overseas Values in Action trip to Cambodia in 2015, Wei Ting stepped up as the student-in-charge of the Interaction Committee. She led her committee members in planning a series of games for the children at the village school. Despite the language barrier, her team managed to break the ice quickly and had a fruitful time interacting with the children. Though she was unwell during the trip, Wei Ting was still eager to be with the team, constantly encouraging them and helping to ensure they remained adequately hydrated.

In her free time, she volunteered as a Housing and Development Board Heartland Ambassador and participated in a series of outreach activities under the “Heartland Ambassador Journey” in different residential estates. Through this, she interacted with the residents and helped to inspire fellow youth and their communities on cultivating good neighbourliness and responsible heartland living. In addition, she was a facilitator for the “Heartland Training Programme” at River Valley Primary School. She led the primary school students on door-to-door meetings in the neighbourhood to train them to be young Heartland Ambassadors. On top of these commitments, she volunteered actively every Saturday for two months as a crowd facilitator for the National Day Parade in 2015.

SPORTSMAN AND SPORTSWOMAN OF THE YEAR AWARD



LIM YONG JIN, 17S18 AND LEE HUI MIN, 18S21

Yong Jin and Hui Min joined JJC Taekwondo Club in 2016 and 2017 respectively. Both of them underwent intense training in order to pick up and perfect the essential skills for poomsae (taekwondo patterns and movements). Training was tough, especially for Hui Min, who had no prior experience in the sport, and thus, had to push herself even harder in order to compete at the national level within a few months of joining the club. Training proved challenging even for the more experienced Yong Jin, who had to strike a balance between his academic work and CCA commitments. Both students displayed great commitment, self-motivation and discipline in their pursuit of sporting excellence.

Selected to represent the college at the 2017 National Inter-School Taekwondo 'A' Division Championships, Hui Min competed in the Yellow Belt Individual and Team events. Not only did she have to perfect her form and execution of poomsae techniques, she also had to ensure precise coordination with her teammates for the Team Event. Her efforts were rewarded as she won a Silver Medal in her individual event, and a Gold Medal in the team event. As for Yong Jin, he also competed in both individual and team events, but in two categories—the Blue and Red Belts. This was especially demanding as he had to master and execute the poomsae for two different belt levels, on top of being mindful of his own and his team's performance. Yong Jin proved that he was up to the challenge, winning the Gold and Bronze Medals for the Blue Belt Team and Individual event respectively. He also won Silver Medals for both the Red Belt Team and Individual events. Hui Min and Yong Jin's efforts contributed to our Taekwondo Club emerging as Overall Champions for Males and clinching Overall 4th Place for Females.

Individually, Yong Jin and Hui Min displayed qualities that made them stand out among their peers. Yong Jin's passion for the sport and positive influence on his peers were recognised as he was appointed as Captain of the club in 2016. As a leader, he remained humble, and supported his teachers and the coach in the planning and execution of training sessions and other club activities. He played a key role in ensuring camaraderie and cohesion within the club. Hui Min was also passionate and enthusiastic about taekwondo. Her charisma and positive attitude allowed her to be a good role model to her peers. She also demonstrated great patience in guiding others and helping them hone their techniques. In recognition of her enthusiasm and leadership skills, Hui Min took over as Captain of the club in 2017.

Yong Jin and Hui Min's dedication to the sport pushes them to continually improve their skills and strive for excellence. Not only have they had a positive impact on those around them, they embody what true athletes can achieve with commitment and perseverance.
